SCARBOROUGH - An easy walk to Higgins Beach, this gorgeous and immaculate New England style home graces the site where the original Len Libby candy shop operated from 1926 into the late 1990s. The location is stunning as well as private. The property's 1.91 acres are waterfront, bordering a lovely maze of marshes that are part of a Rachel Carson Wildlife Refuge.

From the home's three levels of windows, from the deck and the picket-fenced back yard and even from the charming tree house, there are unspoiled, pastoral and panoramic views far across the marshland and to the slopes of Ram Island Farm. These views are everchanging, from the placid beauty of a midsummer day to the dramatic high tides when whitecaps will appear, and from sunrises to magnificent sunsets.

The one-owner builder's home combines traditional Cape architecture with a touch of rusticity (the barnboard of the four-bay garage) and the finest of finishes throughout an interior that totals just over 6,000 square feet, including a daylight, multi-walkout lower level whose rooms are suited to a variety of roles office, exercise, media, recreation and more.

The main level flows beautifully, with water views ever-present. The family room with gas fireplace (one of three in the home) leads into a spacious, bright, dine-in kitchen, with high-end white appliances, Corian

counters including island, and subtly pickled birch cabinetry. French doors open into an elegant, front-to-back living room/dining room.
